






Set your sights on parasites.




U.S. dog park study confirms the need to test and treat even well-cared for dogs.⁹

- + Approximately 3,000 fresh canine fecal specimens were collected.
- + 288 dog parks in 30 metropolitan areas in the U.S. were included.
- + Fecal Dx™ antigen testing, *Giardia* antigen testing, and fecal flotation by centrifugation were conducted.

Key results:



85% of parks tested positive for an intestinal parasite.



1 in 5 dogs tested positive for intestinal parasites.

In a similar study performed in Alberta, Canada, involving 774 participants with fecal specimens being collected from 7 dedicated off-leash dog parks, the overall prevalence of canine intestinal parasites in client-owned dogs was similar to numbers of parasite infections from dog parks in the northwestern U.S.¹⁰



50% of dog parks tested positive for hookworms, roundworms, or whipworms.
