

Zebra LP2824 and LP2824 Plus Printer Configuration

This document provides detailed instructions for changing the label size and orientation for the Zebra LP2824 and LP2824 Plus Label Printers installed on Cornerstone* systems.

Determine how the printer is connected

Connected with a parallel cable or USB cable:

- All operations will be performed on the station to which the printer is physically connected.

Connected via an external or internal print server using an Ethernet cable:

- All operations will be performed on the Server computer.

Required Label Size and Orientation for use with Cornerstone software

Note: It is important to use the EPL version of the ZDesigner driver. If any other version is used, the labels will not print correctly.

Prescription Label Settings:

1. Open **Run**.
2. Type **Control Printers**.
3. Open the Zebra printer preferences window:
Windows 10, Windows 8, Windows 7, Windows Server 2012, and Windows Server 2008
 - a) Right-click the Zebra printer.
 - b) Click **Printer Properties**.
 - c) On the **General** tab, click **Preferences**.Windows XP, Windows Vista and Windows Server 2003
 - a) Right-click the Zebra printer.
 - b) Click **Properties**.
 - c) Click **Printing Preferences**.
4. After opening preferences, set the following settings on the **Options** tab:
 - a) Click the radio button next to **Landscape**.
 - b) Click the checkbox next to **rotate 180°**.
 - c) Set the **Width** to **2.0**.
 - d) Set the **Height** to **3.50**.
 - e) Click **Ok**.
5. Click on the **Advanced** tab, then click on **Printing Defaults**.
6. On the **Options** tab, set the following settings:
 - a) Click the radio button next to **Landscape**.
 - b) Click the checkbox next to **rotate 180°**.
 - c) Set the **Width** to **2.0**.
 - d) Set the **Height** to **3.50**.
 - e) Click **Ok**.
7. Click **Ok**.

Test Tube Label Settings:

1. Open Run.
2. Type Control Printers.
3. Open the Zebra printer preferences window:
 - Windows 10, Windows 8, Windows 7, Windows Server 2012, and Windows Server 2008
 - d) Right-click the Zebra printer.
 - e) Click Printer Properties.
 - f) On the General tab, click Preferences.
 - Windows XP, Windows Vista and Windows Server 2003
 - d) Right-click the Zebra printer.
 - e) Click Properties.
 - f) Click Printing Preferences.
4. After opening preferences, set the following settings on the Options tab:
 - a) Click the radio button next to Portrait.
 - b) Click the checkbox next to rotate 180°.
 - c) Set the Width to 1.25.
 - d) Set the Height to .84.
 - e) Click Ok.
5. Click on the Advanced tab, then click on Printing Defaults.
6. On the Options tab, set the following settings:
 - a) Click the radio button next to Portrait.
 - b) Click the checkbox next to rotate 180°.
 - c) Set the Width to 1.25.
 - d) Set the Height to .84.
 - e) Click Ok.
7. Click Ok.
